Introduction and Objectives:

Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's, Shri. Raosaheb Ramrao Patil Mahavidyalaya, Savlaj was established in the year 1991. The college aims at the overall development of the students to become entrepreneurs and professionals in the respective disciplines. Every year, a survey is conducted to assess the satisfaction of all the stakeholders (Students, Alumni, Teachers, and Employers) regarding curriculum of the college. The college is permanently affiliated to Shivaji University, Kolhapur and follows curriculum prescribed by the university. Receiving positive or negative feedback from these stakeholders is important as both these are crucial in helping monitor and evaluate the academic and administrative activities in the college. Listening to what stakeholders have to say is a contributing factor to running a successful college or institution.

Methodology:

In every academic year, we ask all the stakeholders to fill a feedback form which is made available on college website. Every year, data is collected during the period from 1st March to 10th March. For this academic year, data was collected during the period 1st June to 20th June 2023. The link of feedback form was made available to all stakeholders on their email address, WhatsApp account and also college website. Filling of feedback is voluntary.

For the academic year 2022-23, there were 384 registered students at the college. One Hundred seven (107) final year students, 57 alumni, 20 teachers and 9 employers responded to the survey. The analyses presented in this report are based on the responses of these stakeholders to the survey.

Design of Feedback

The responses from the students are collected on the two-point scale.

- 1) Yes
- 2) No

The responses from the teachers are collected on the four-point scale.

- 1) A: 76-100 Marks
- 2) B: 51-75 Marks
- 3) C: 26-50 Marks
- 4) D: 0-25 Marks

The responses from alumni are collected on the four-point scale.

- 1) Excellent
- 2) Good



- 3) Satisfactory
- 4) Unsatisfactory

The responses from employers are collected on the four-point scale.

- 1) Excellent
- 2) Good
- 3) Satisfactory
- 4) Poor

Overall Evaluation

Feedback Analysis Report of all Stakeholders for Academic Year: - 2022-23

Feedback was collected and analyzed by Feedback Analysis Committee of the college. Opinions of all stakeholders are obtained about each parameter in percentage.

Students' Feedback:

The respondent sample is broadly representative of the student population with respect to gender, programme level and course. We have received 64 students' online feedback on the syllabus of various programs designed by Shivaji University, Kolhapur. There are 36 female and 28 male respondents in the survey sample.

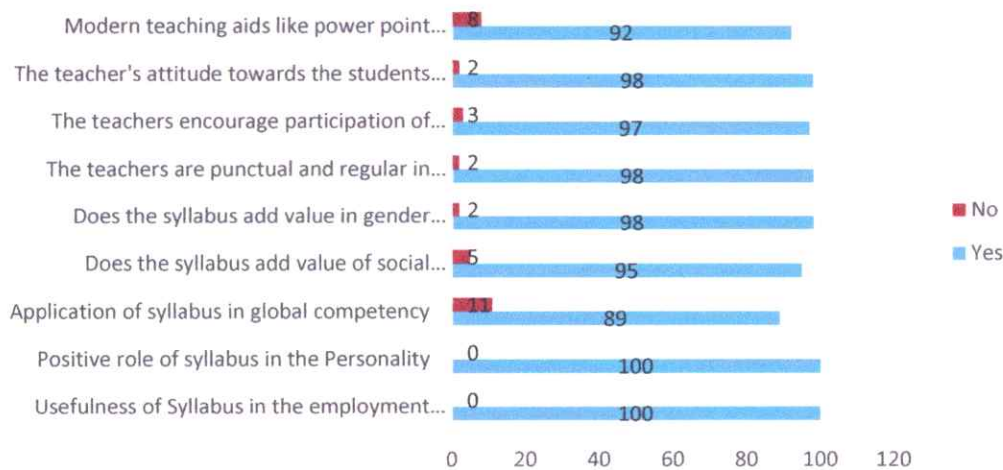
Following chart and table shows the summary of the responses given by students for each parameter.

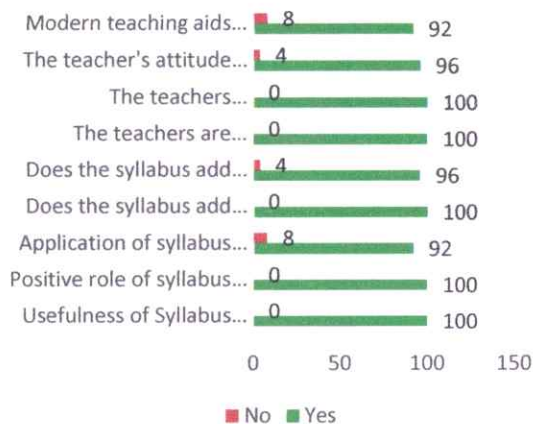
Students' Feedback on Curriculum in %



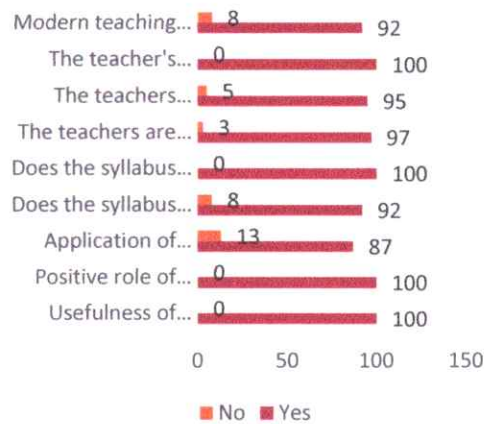
About 100% students agree with the current syllabus which is suitable for employment and entrepreneurship. About 100% students are agree with the current syllabus plays positive role into the personality development. More than 89% students agree with the curriculum which develop global competence, whereas 11% do not agree with it. About 95% students agree with the syllabus add value of social responsibility and social justice. But there are 5% students who do not agree with it. About 98% students agree with the syllabus add value in gender equality, human values and environmental awareness and about 92% students are satisfied with the use of modern teaching aids. Overall it seems that majority of the students have rated yes for all the points considered here.

Students Feedback of Science Faculty in %

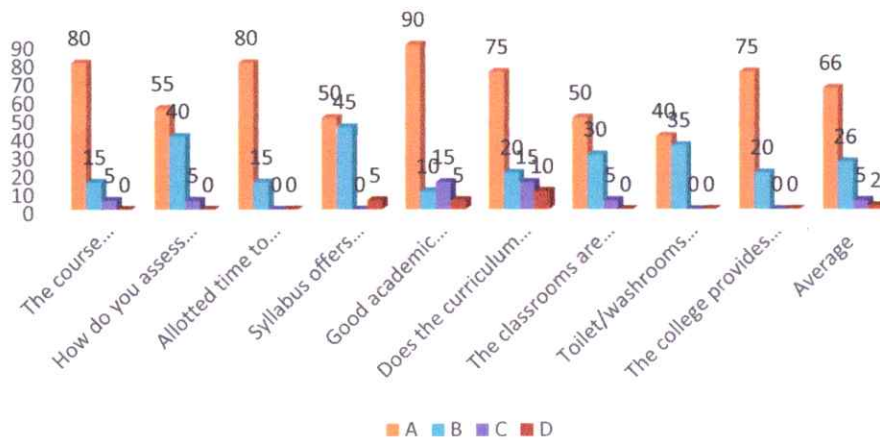


Teachers' Feedback

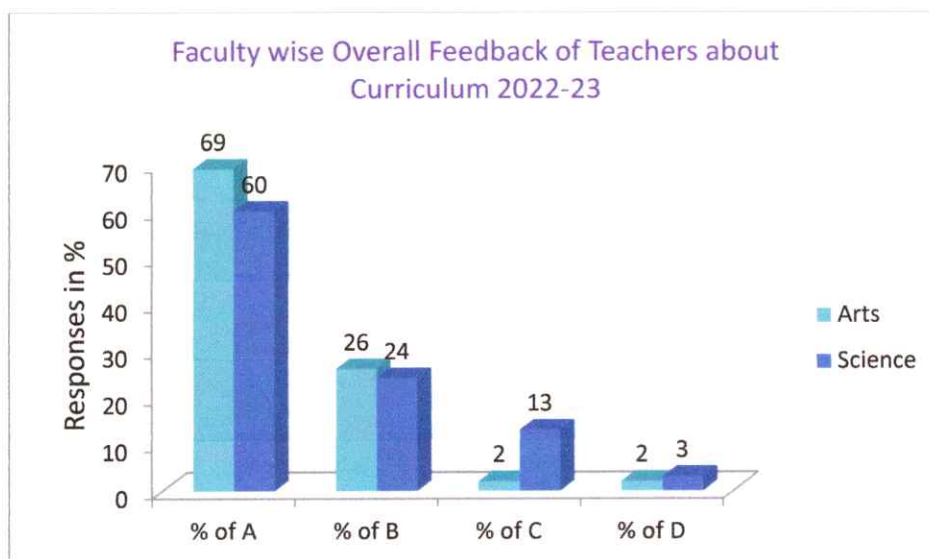
We have received 18 teachers' online feedback on the syllabus of various programmes designed by Shivaji University, Kolhapur. There are 12 males and 6 female respondents in the survey sample. Following table shows the summary of the responses given by teacher for each parameter (in %).

Teachers Feedback on Curriculum



About 80% teachers give around 76-100 marks and 15% teachers give 51-75 marks to the course outcomes are understood by students. About 55% teachers give 76-100 marks and 40% teachers give 51-75 marks to the assessment of student's difficulties regarding syllabus. About 80% teachers agree with the allotted time to complete the syllabus is sufficient but 15% teachers are not agreeing with it. About 50% teachers agree with the syllabus offers research possibilities but 45% teachers do not agree with it. About 90% teachers agree with the curriculum has academic flexibility and 5% are do not agree with it. About 75% teachers agree with that the syllabus includes cross cutting issues like gender and environment but 10% teachers do not agree with it. Around 50% teacher's give 76-100 marks and 20% teachers give 51-75 marks to classrooms are clean and properly maintained point. About 40% and 35% teachers give 76-100 and 51-75 marks respectively to cleanliness of toilet and washrooms. 75% teachers give 76-100 marks because they agree that the current syllabus gives opportunity and support to faculty for upgrading their skills.



Most of the teachers give 76-100 marks to the current curriculum of the graduation level. There is 26% of arts and 60% from science faculty members who give 51-75 marks to the current

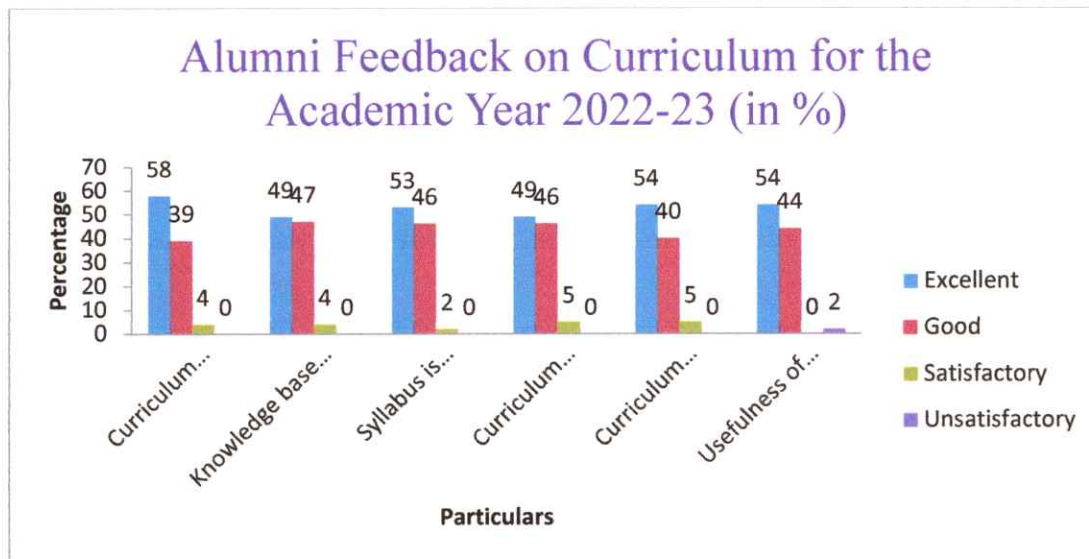


syllabus. There are also some teachers (2%, 3%) from arts and science faculty who gives 26-50 and 0-25 marks respectively to the syllabus.

• **Alumni's Feedback:-**

We have received online feedbacks of 60 alumni on the syllabus of various programmes designed by Shivaji University, Kolhapur. There are 38 female and 22 male respondents in the survey sample. Following chart and table shows the summary (in %) of the responses given by alumnus for each parameter.

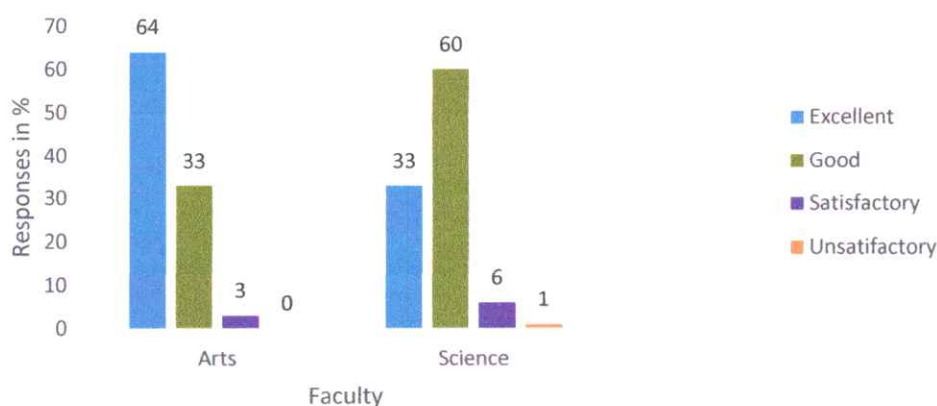

About 58% alumni say excellent and 39% says good about the current syllabus which is suitable for employability in the present scenario of students. About 49% alumni say excellent and 47% says good to the curriculum which is Knowledge based. About 53% say excellent and 46% say

good about the current Syllabus is revised by the university as per the requirement of the stakeholders and 2% of alumni are satisfied with it. About 49% alumni say excellent, 46% are say good and 5% are satisfied satisfied with curriculum which is suitable for overall development of students. About 54% of alumni say excellent and 40% say good about curriculum develop the global competence of students and 5% of alumni are satisfied with it. About 54% alumni say excellent and 44% says good the current syllabus which is useful for employment of entrepreneurship but 2% alumni were unsatisfied with it.

Faculty-wise feedback by Alumni on Curriculum for the academic year 2022-23



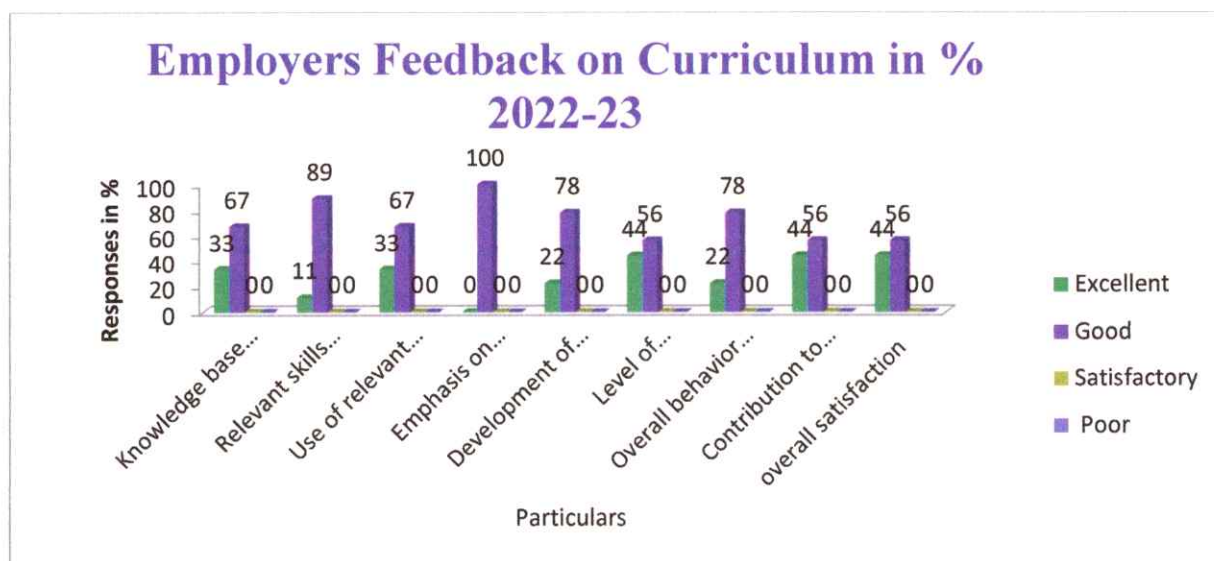
Most of the students who did their graduation from arts and science faculty (64% and 33%) completely agree with the current syllabus adopted by institution, whereas some of the alumni 3% from arts faculty and 6% from science faculty satisfied with it.

There are about 33% employers says excellent and 67% says good to the current syllabus is knowledge based. About 89% employers believe in the current syllabus which incorporates the relevant skills whereas 11% are satisfied with it. About 100% employers agree that the current syllabus helps in emphasizing innovative thinking. 67% employers agree with the relevant technology taught by the curriculum and 33% agrees with it. About 78% employers agree with the development of professional ethics targeted by the curriculum whereas 22% are satisfied with it. About 56% employers are says that level of competency in the relevant field that the curriculum can create in the student. About 78% employers agree that behavior with the colleagues/people also contribution to development of organization/nation is excellent. Most of the employers (72%) are satisfied with the current syllabus.

1. There is a need of canteen in college.

3. Open gym facility for students be provided.
4. Need to have a separate teacher for each subject.
5. All rules made by the college are good for student.
