Academic Year- 2023-24 Feedback Committee Feedback Analysis Report

Introduction and Objectives:

Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's, Shri. Raosaheb Ramrao Patil Mahavidyalaya, Savlaj was established in the year 1991. The college aims at the overall development of the students to become entrepreneurs and professionals in the respective disciplines. Every year a survey was conducted to assess the satisfaction of all the stakeholders (Students, Alumni, Teachers, and Employers) regarding curriculum of the college. The college is permanently affiliated to Shivaji University, Kolhapur and follows curriculum prescribed by the university. Receiving positive or negative feedback from these stakeholders is important as both these are crucial in helping monitor and evaluate the academic and administrative activities in the college. Listening to what stakeholders have to say is a contributing factor to running a successful college or institution.

Methodology:

In every academic year, we ask all the stakeholders to fill a feedback form which is made available on college website. Every year, data is collected during the period from 1st March to 10th March. For this academic year, data was collected during the period 1st August to 20th Sept. 2024. The link of feedback form was made available to all stakeholders on their Email address, WhatsApp account and also college website. Filling of feedback is voluntary.

For the academic year 2023-24, there were 357 registered students at the college. 50 students, 47 alumni, 20 teachers and 8 employers responded to the survey. The analyses presented in this report are based on the responses of these stakeholders to the survey.

Design of Feedback

The responses from Students, Teachers Alumni and Employers are collected on the four-point scale.

- 1) Excellent
- 2) Good
- 3) Satisfactory
- 4) Poor

Overall Evaluation: -

Feedback was collected and analysed by Feedback Analysis Committee of the


college. Opinion of all stakeholders are obtained about each parameter in percentage.

Student Feedback: -


The respondent sample is broadly representative of the student population with respect to gender, programme level and course. We have received 50 students' online feedback on the syllabus of various programs designed by Shivaji University, Kolhapur. There are 41 female and 23 male respondents in the survey sample.


About 32% students agree with the current syllabus which is suitable for employment and entrepreneurship whereas 3% do not agree with it. About 62% students are agree with the current syllabus plays positive role into the personality development. More than 52% students agree with the curriculum which develop global competence, whereas 4% do not agree with it. 50% students agree with the syllabus add value of social responsibility and social justice. 50% students agree with the syllabus add value in gender equality, human values and environmental awareness. There are 48% students who agree for the punctuality of the teachers. 44% students think that teachers encourage students to participate in group discussions and other activities and 52% students reckon that teachers are friendly in their attitude. 54% students are satisfied with the use of modern teaching aids. Overall, it seems that majority of the students have rated yes for all the points considered here.



Teachers Feedback



There are 65% teachers who think that the course outcomes are understood by the student. There are 45% teachers that rate the difficulty level of the syllabus as excellent and only 10%

are satisfied with it. 50% teachers feel that allotted time to complete the syllabus is sufficient and syllabus offers research possibilities. There are 45% teachers agree that there is good academic flexibility in the curriculum. There are 30% teachers feel that the classrooms are clean and well maintained and toilet/washrooms are clean and properly maintained. 50% teachers feel that the college provides adequate opportunities and support to faculty for upgrading their skills and qualifications.




Alumni Feedback




